


## RIP.IE Procedures

Go to rip.ie.

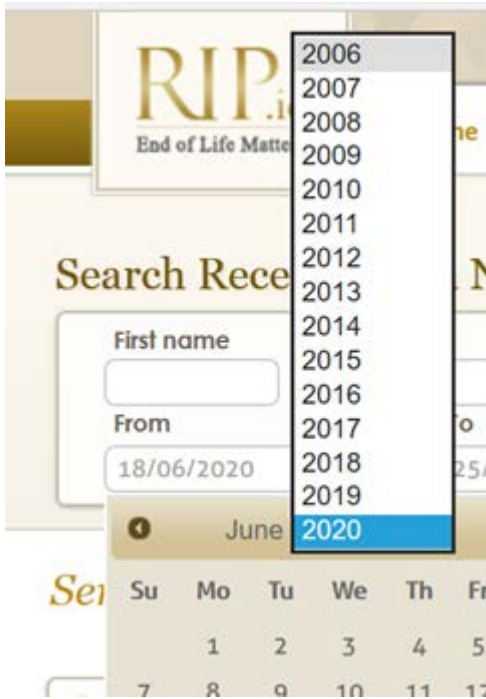
The date field automatically defaults to the last seven days. This can be changed.

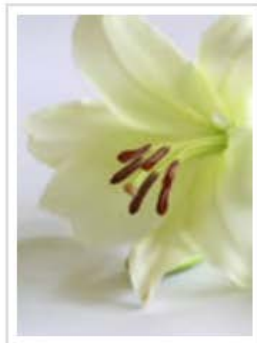
People may have multiple residences so death notices are recorded per residence. For instance:

<a href="#">Dalton, Nora</a>	Kilcrohane	Cork	27/05/18
<a href="#">Dalton, Nora</a>	Mahon	Cork	27/05/18

The names are hyperlinks to the death notice which opens in the same browser tab. This is important to remember because after viewing the notice and hitting the back button, your search results may be erased depending upon the browser used. I suggest right clicking on the name and opening in a new tab.
